

PRELUDE

The service begins with the presiding minister saying the following near the entrance of the church.

PREPARATION

May the Lord God live in a high, holy place
for the sake of those who have a broken and contrite heart.
Purify our hearts and minds.

so that we can approach you in our prayers,
worship you in spirit and truth.
Bless our service in this service
and bless everyone who came to this place to worship you.

from eternity, and now and forever. Amen.

Silent Prayer of the congregation

**O heavenly Father,
I thank you that I can come to this place
to hear your holy Word,
pray and be spiritually strengthened
in partaking of your Holy Table.
Give me peace of mind and quiet my thoughts
so that I can hear what the Spirit wants to say to me.
Hear my prayer for the sake of Jesus Christ, my Savior. Amen.**

The congregation stands. They sing the introduction song.

SONG

As the song is sung, ministers enter the sanctuary and pause just before the chancel and bow their heads toward the altar for a few seconds. They then go to the altar, kneel down and pray silently or in a low voice. They then stand, facing the altar until the song that the congregation is singing ends. Then, the presiding leader says,

Beloved in the Lord:
Let us begin the worship of this day of the Lord
in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit
Amen.

COLLECT

O God of Grace,
you have given us minds to know You,
hearts to love You,

and voices to sing Your praises.
We ask you to fill us with your Holy Spirit,
so that we can celebrate your glory
and worship you in spirit and truth.
To Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, Amen.

The Lord our God is here.
He is with us.
Let us worship him,
let us eat him;
let us hear how he teaches us in his Word!

CONFESSION OF SIN AND ABSOLUTION

Jesus says,
“Love the Lord your God with all your heart,
with all your soul,
with all your mind,
and with all your strength;

O Lord, forgive me all my sins,
give me the power of your Holy Spirit.
Let me take a new course. Amen**

then, through the power of his Word
and by the order of our Lord Jesus Christ,
I declare that God by his grace
has forgiven us all our sins.
In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
